CAD TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP 2016

Because of the extraordinary need for CADD professionals in Northern Illinois, a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 has been established by donors to the Kishwaukee College CAD Technology Program and faculty of same. The scholarship is to recognize outstanding high school students of the Kishwaukee College or Sauk Valley Community College Districts who wish to major in the field of Computer-Aided Drafting and Design (CADD). The scholarship must be utilized for tuition, fees and books at Kishwaukee College in the CAD Technology Program the year it is awarded.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a high school senior student of the Kishwaukee College or Sauk Valley Community College Districts when they apply.
2. Applicant awarded the scholarship must hold a high school GPA of 2.50 or higher.
3. Applicant awarded the scholarship must declare themselves as a major in at least one of the four CAD curriculum (#412, 413, 414 or 415) of the Kishwaukee College CAD Technology Program upon entrance to the college.
4. Applicant awarded the scholarship must be enrolled full-time carrying a minimum of 12 semester hours in CAD immediately following high school graduation.
5. Applicant selected for this scholarship may be recognized in college press releases.
6. Applicant must be a resident of the Kishwaukee College District.
7. Students awarded this scholarship in the Sauk Valley Community College District may be required to take general education courses in that district in which case this scholarship would not be used to pay for such courses taken at Sauk Valley.

Selection:

1. Selection of the recipient will be made by a CAD Technology scholarship committee consisting of the following possible members:

Career Technology Division Dean
Career Technology Division Faculty
CAD Technology Advisory Program Committee Members
CAD Technology Program Donors

2. Preference will be given to students who have demonstrated a/an:
- * Above average (2.5) GPA
 - * Contest Award Recipient (like I.D.E.A.)
 - * Ethics
 - * Internship or Work Experience
 - * Contribution to Community
 - * Exceeding Expectations
 - * Classroom Participation
 - * Three Letters of Reference
 - * Contribution to High School
 - * Financial Need
3. Only one award will be granted per year as funds are available.

Application Deadline:

Submit a completed application form (with support materials) before May 1st 2016.

Award of Scholarship:

The amount of \$1,000 will be deposited in the recipient's Kishwaukee College student account on, or about, December 1st of the recipient student's first year of attendance registered as a declared major in the Kishwaukee College CAD Technology Program. Failure to be so registered in CAD courses and declared as a major will void this scholarship opportunity.

Majors to be declared in for eligibility reasons include:

- Curriculum #412 Computer-Aided Architectural Design A.A.S. Degree (64 Credits)
- Curriculum #413 Computer-Aided Mechanical Design A.A.S. Degree (64 Credits)
- Curriculum #414 Computer-Aided Architectural Drafting Certificate (23 Credits)
- Curriculum #415 Computer-Aided Mechanical Drafting Certificate (25 Credits)
